Assessment in Integrated Programme

2014- 2015 is the first academic year that the Ministry of Education and Training has been innovative assessment in primary school. Elementary students only have examinations at the end of the Semester 1 and the end of the school year. Teachers of Singapore Vietnam primary school have quickly grasped these innovations to organize the first exam in school extremely effectively.

The test papers are designed based on the standards of the primary students' knowledge and skills. Teachers swap classes for marking and checking the tests. Students in the class are well prepared for the final semester exam.

The staff of KinderWorld schools were very proud and excited to hear of the success of students in the recent iPSLE and Cambridge exams. These exams are set by groups from Singapore and the UK and respected worldwide for their quality and excellence, and are operated under the strictest security.

In the iPSLE two former students of Van Phuc received outstanding results. Vu Hai Nhi in Year 6 earned an A for English and Maths and a B for Science. While Tran Quynh Anh obtained an A for English and A* for Mathematics. Tran Nguyen Nam Anh obtained an A* for Mathematics and an A for both English and Science. Both Tran Quynh Anh and Tran Nguyen Nam Anh were awarded Certificate of Outstanding Subject Performance by the Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board.

In the Cambridge exams four Cau Giay students were the best in all of Vietnam. This included Nguyen Hoang Minh Anh who studied at Van Phuc.
